

CTLTC ELROD & GRAVES LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

THE PURPOSE:

The CTLTC Board of Directors provide \$1,000 academic scholarships to recognize exceptional graduating seniors who consistently demonstrate Christian leadership qualities.

Scholarship recipients can use these awards for academic expenses at the school they choose to attend. This Scholarship is released to the school's scholarship administrators once enrollment is confirmed. This award is active for one academic year. Recipients can access this scholarship starting the fall semester of the current convention year.

THE QUALIFICATIONS:

Only seniors registered as participating, and attending, students in the current CTLTC convention are eligible. Their leadership qualities are witnessed in their conduct, competence, confidence and character in a variety of settings.

THE PROCESS:

This scholarship is values-driven. Since we only know you by what you write, it's important you represent yourself and your leadership qualities well and with deliberation. While membership in school groups, participation in church activities and involvement in worship services are worthy attributes of a good life, they **do not define leadership**. Therefore, the CTLTC Scholarship Committee is interested in the student's understanding and practical demonstration of leadership.

What do we mean? A good starting point are the words of John 5:30. **How, as a young leader, are you doing the will of the Father?** Prove to us, through your words that you exhibit the will of Father through your Christian leadership. Demonstrate your competence, confidence and character in leadership moments.

How? Complete this application and include the following documents:

- an essay demonstrating your Christian leadership
- an essay describing a Biblical leader you admire and why; how you've applied these lessons in your own life
- a letter from an elder, or church leader, commenting on your leadership observed in a spiritual context
- a letter from a school leader commenting on the leadership observed in your academic life
- a letter from a community leader commenting on the leadership observed in a civic context
- a letter from a parent, or guardian, describing why this scholarship will benefit your education
- a letter from you explaining why you want this scholarship
- scholarship morality clause

Your scholarship will be received by the CTLTC Scholarship Committee Chair (scholarship@ctltc.net). To properly and fairly process your application, **please reference the Convention Calendar for application submission deadline.** Any submissions dated after this deadline will not be considered. Incomplete application packages will not be considered. All documents, and attachments, submitted online must be .pdf files.
